

# CMU-TEGS TEST PREPARATION



## 1. Course Description

This 120-hour CMU-TEGS Test Preparation course is designed to systematically prepare students for the CMU-TEGS examination through a structured four-phase program. The course develops foundational language skills, strengthens academic listening and reading abilities, integrates test strategies with full practice sets, and builds test readiness through mock examinations. Emphasis is placed on strategic test-taking, timing control, error analysis, and score improvement techniques to maximize student performance.

1. Demonstrate understanding of the CMU-TEGS format, question types, and scoring system.
2. Apply effective listening and reading strategies under timed test conditions.
3. Complete full CMU-TEGS practice tests with improved accuracy, confidence, and score performance.
